NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON INCREAS

A tax rate of \$0.0300 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Hidalgo County Emergency Service District No. 2.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Hidalgo County Emergency Service District No. 2 from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Hidalgo County Emergency Service District No. 2 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Hidalgo County Emergency Service District No. 2 is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 4, 2025 AT 12:00 PM AT Monte Alto Recreation Center, 25164 FM 88, Monte Alto, Texas 78538.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Hidalgo County Emergency Service District No. 2 is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Board of Directors of Hidalgo County Emergency Service District No. 2 at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.
